# Willoughby House – (formerly McFadden Ranch) (TJJD):

• Because of the McFadden youth being moved to the west side of Fort Worth, and the times we are allowed to visit, my interaction with them has been minimal. This may change, waiting to see.

#### Gainesville State School (TJJD):

• At this point, Gainesville is still not open to most volunteers. Since we are in a new year, I think they may allow me to visit once a month. Not real encouraging. Waiting to see how it goes. A new Superintendent and lack of staff are some of the problems contributing to the wait.

### Hope Inn Christ (Decatur, TX):

• Hope Inn Christ still has one youth there. His name is Marvin. He has been there since July. He DOES like Bible study! He is working at the Braums in Decatur and likes it. I was able to see him for a while, but now that he is working, I have not been able to see him as regularly as I used to. He has had his struggles, but seems to be doing better now.

### TDCJ (Adult Prisons, all over TX):

• Still keeping in touch with Angel. He is in a unit in south Texas. Back in August his brother was murdered in Dallas. He is 20 and his brother was only 19. He took this pretty hard as they were very close. Trying to make sure he doesn't give up on life. He was enrolled in a class to teach him woodworking, but the instructor quit recently, so we will have to see what happens. I am hopeful he keeps busy because that takes his mind off of things.
