An update on what has happened recently (October 1, 2023 thru March 31, 2024):

Sorry for missing the last newsletter that was supposed to come out back at the beginning of January. My Mom passed away on December 24th, so I took some personal time. I hope you will excuse me. Not a whole lot went on during the last 6 months anyway.

Gainesville State School (TJJD):

• At this time, we are still only allowed to go in once a month. But I keep getting told that this should soon end and maybe we will be able to have Bible studies and mentoring on a weekly basis. They have been saying that for a while, and with all of these facilities, the progress is always REAL SLOW. But I am still trying. Please pray that we get approved to where we can hopefully make a difference in some of these youths' lives.

Hope Inn Christ (Decatur, TX):

- The new house parents are amazing! They started I think around the end of the summer and it wasn't long until we had some youth out there. This is a very demanding job and it is hard to keep them. So far, they have done great and have a passion for helping the youth entrusted to their care. They really connect with the youth and have a heart for God!
- We have had 5 young men come thru there, but 3 have been asked to leave for one reason or another. I think it's the original 2 that are still there! One is Andrew and the other young man is Josiah. I got to work with Josiah when he was in Gainesville, so I already knew him. (He was one of the youth that got baptized in Gainesville.) I also got to encourage him when I had found out that he applied to go to Hope Inn Christ. Both young men are doing REAL WELL! They go to church on Wednesday and Sunday, and also go to a group (kind of like Celebrate Recovery) on Tuesdays. They have both been baptized and are trying to live for the Lord! Praise God!

TDCJ (Adult Prisons, all over TX):

• Still keeping in touch with Angel. He is still in a unit in south Texas. We are still communicating when he can call me. I still would like to visit him – haven't been able to recently, but hopefully I will soon. He currently works in the warehouse for a job while there. He likes it a lot. But I am trying to help keep him focused on taking the second electrical class – if they have one. He has already completed the first electrician program! They are STILL trying to get a more advanced course that he would be able to attend. I think he has found his trade! He seems to be doing well, but still has not given his life to Christ at this point. Please remember him in prayer as well.

Teen Life Challenge (Desoto, TX):

• I ended up having to leave Teen Life Challenge at the end of October. It was a VERY difficult decision that I had to make, but the new management were doing some things that would not be considered 'above reproach.' I hated leaving the guys I worked with, but they had been asking me about things that were going on and it began to look like I supported what the management were doing. I do however stay in touch with several of the young men.

Tarrant County Juvenile Services (Fort Worth, TX):

• At the beginning of the year, I took the training that was required in order to be allowed to go into the facility. Again, the wheels turn REAL SLOWLY there as well. So we will have to see how long now it will really take to get in to work with the youth there. Anxious to get in – as I was approved right before the COVID shutdown – right now, that's been 4 years!
