An update on what has happened recently (April 1 thru September 30, 2024):

Gainesville State School (TJJD):

• At this time, we are **still** only allowed to go in once a month. But I keep getting told that this should soon end and maybe we will be able to have Bible studies and mentoring on a weekly basis. They have been saying that for a while, and with all of these facilities, the progress is always REAL SLOW. But I am still trying. Please pray that we get approved to where we can hopefully make a difference in some of these youths' lives. They had a baptism, but I am not sure all the youth really understand what it is for and what it means. Please pray for them.

Hope Inn Christ (Decatur, TX):

- The house parents are still doing an amazing job! This is a very demanding job and it is hard to keep good house parents. So far, they have done great and have a passion for helping the youth entrusted to their care. They have really connected with the youth and have a heart for God!
- We have had 8 young men come thru there, but 5 have been asked to leave for one reason or another. The youth that has been there the longest is Josiah. He just got his high school diploma! Another is Cordy. He is doing well and coming along great so far. The newest youth is Michael. He just came in September. All three youth are doing well so far. Which is a HUGE praise! They still go to church on Wednesday and Sunday, and also go to a group (kind of like Celebrate Recovery) on Tuesdays. Josiah and Cordy have both been baptized and are trying to live for the Lord! Praise God!

TDCJ (Adult Prisons, all over TX):


• Still keeping in touch with Angel. He is still in a unit in south Texas. We are still communicating when he can call me. I still would like to visit him – haven't been able to recently, but hopefully I will soon. He currently works in the lunchroom for lunch. He likes it a lot. But I am trying to help keep him focused on taking the second electrical class – if they ever have one. He has already completed the first electrician program! They are STILL trying to get a more advanced course that he would be able to attend. I think he has found his trade! He seems to be doing well, but still has not given his life to Christ at this point. He even got trained to be a mentor for math! (Which was his worst subject!) He enjoys being able to help others. Also, he recently came up for parole, but was denied. Please keep him in your prayers that he doesn't give up. He has made great progress! Now he needs to be saved! Please remember him in prayer as well.
